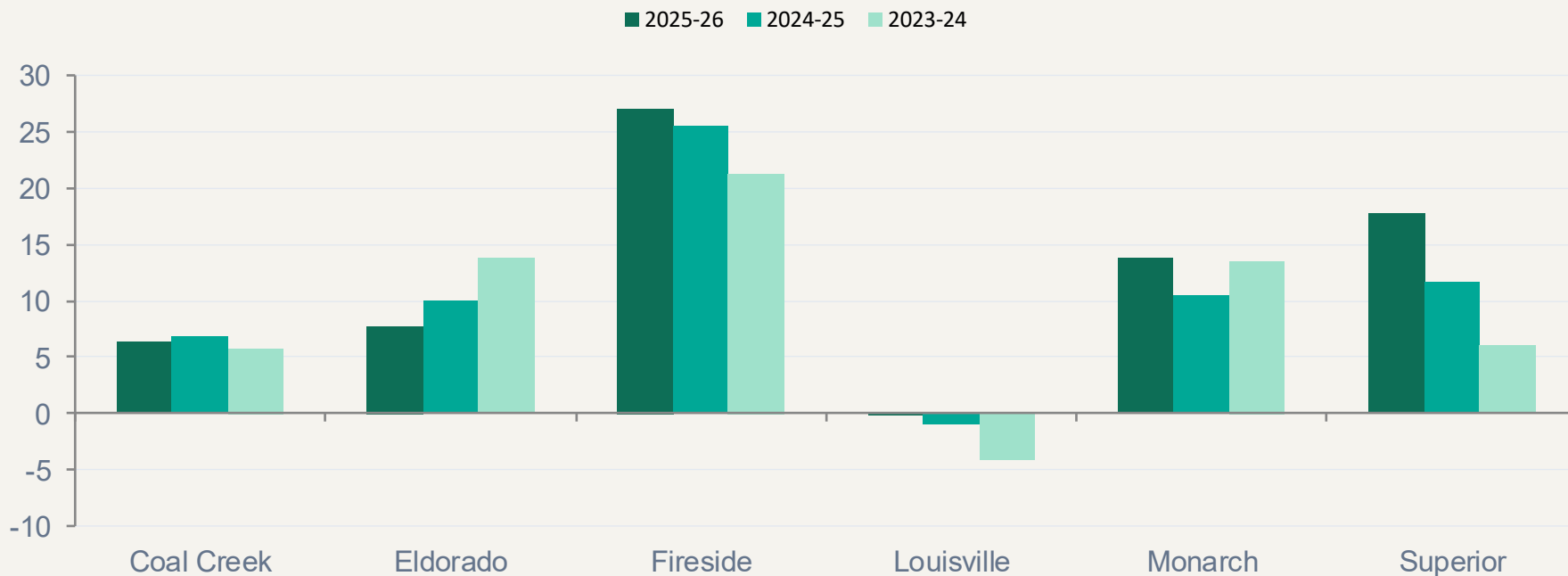


Open enrollment demand: Which schools families choose

What this chart shows

Each bar represents the net result of family choice: open enrollment students choosing *into* a school, minus neighborhood students choosing to leave for a different one. This is shown as a percentage of total enrollment so schools of different sizes can be compared fairly. **A positive bar means more families are seeking the school out than leaving it. A negative bar means the reverse.**



Net OE = (OE-In + Out-of-District) minus OE-Out, as % of total enrollment. Positive = net inbound demand.
